Thee Auld Hussie will settle back, but with the likelihood of a good pace, will finish off strongly here. She went ok on Monday in a much stronger race and is proven on a quick back up. Her form in Brisbane last winter was easily good enough for a race like this. King Of Soul battled on well under a hefty weight last week. Light weight hopes include Down To Earth, Aerosol and Darkside Lass, who hit the line well 2 starts back. Talons Shown has the ability to feature, but has been very disappointing at both Bris runs.

### Race Summary

Some of the pace/depth has gone from this race with the scratchings. Persuades should lead now, with Myndos, A Little Naughty and Sir Monashee not far away. Miss Mooney Mooney holds the key here, being superbly weighted at the set weights conditions. She has a series of ratings that simply win this race, including her 2 runs back, but has a poor win strike rate. No excuses here in a race that is the easiest she has contested in 12 months. Sir Monashee is a talented 3yo and 1100m looks perfect for him, after finding 1200m a shade far last time. Looks like securing a lovely run. A Little Naughty had problems last week but is right in this on her excellent run 2 back and will also get a soft run. Persuades is also up to this and the scratchings help her cause. Myndos faces its toughest test yet 1st up here.

The draw is no help for her.

The two standouts on ratings, Flying Alpha and Readyforcatherine have both drawn poorly, but with a good pace on, they should be able to run home strongly, and with even luck, will be right in the finish. Freeroller is racing very well and pays for that, going up to 56.5kg today. To offset that, she has drawn better than her main rivals. Romare and Really Flying have southern ratings to win this, but need to improve on their last start efforts. Serenote will be running home as well. Expect improvement from Laura's Charm and Hasta La Ciao Ciao today.

King Rex, Classiconi and Panzer all have the ability to figure here, if they perform to their best. Sir Breakfast is always competitive in these type of races.
